Pelham Hall 100 Club

PELHAM HALL is the Village Hall for Penallt. The original Hall dated back to 1923. The "new" Hall was opened in 1992. It's a great asset to the village and its activities and clubs are well supported.

However, various parts of the Hall needed to be upgraded/renewed/repainted. So, the **Pelham Hall 100 Club** was set up in 2015 to generate income for the upkeep and maintenance of the Hall over the longer term and to give members a chance to win cash prizes!

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Pelham Hall 100 Club members pledge £5 each month or £60 annually (or you can have multiple subscriptions!).

50% of each donation goes to the Hall maintenance fund and 50% is for prizes in the MONTHLY DRAWS as well as six-monthly BIG PRIZE DRAWS.

To date, the 100 Club has raised over £5,000 for the Hall funds and awarded a similar amount in prize money.

WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO?

So far the funds raised have gone towards the replacement of windows, lighting and kitchen upgrade.

NEXT PROJECTS? A lift for disabled/elderly, solar panels....

WHAT COULD I WIN?

MONTHLY PRIZE DRAWS:

Normally take place on the 3rd Thursday of each month at the Social Evening in the Village Hall., though during Covid times the draw takes place online (with witnesses to check the draw rules are followed).

All members who have subscribed for that month will be eligible for the MONTHLY PRIZE DRAW.

FIRST PRIZE is £1 multiplied by the number of subscribers that month. So, 50 subscribers means a £50 first prize - 100 subscribers means a £100 first prize!

SECOND PRIZE is 50p multiplied by the number of subscribers that month: 50 subscribers and the 2nd prize will be £25 or for 100 subscribers it will be £50!

BIG PRIZE DRAWS every 6 months:

In June and December each year, there is a BIG PRIZE DRAW with two BIG prizes for those who have subscribed for the previous 6 months. The size of the "pot" depends on the number of subscribers, e.g. With 50 members, the BIG PRIZES are £200 and £100 and if 100 members, the BIG PRIZES would be £400 and £200!

DO I HAVE TO BE PRESENT

AT THE DRAW?

No. It would be great if you were present, but it's not necessary. Prize winners will be notified by email and the prize paid by cheque/BACS. The winners' names will be on the Penallt website so you can always check there!
